

Scholarship Mature Age - Terms and Conditions

- Scholarships and bursaries are not applicable with any other offer.
- Deferral or not accepting this scholarship or bursary offer, forfeits this offer.
- A leave of absence or gap in studies, unless expressively approved, forfeits this offer. Requests for leave will be assessed on a case-by-case basis and consideration will be taken into whether the scholarship offer shall be extended.
- This offer is only valid for the course enrolled in upon accepting this offer and will not rollover if a student is to change their course.
- This scholarship is offered to full fee-paying students only and will be withdrawn for students on a payment plan, other than FEE-HELP or HECS-HELP.
- Available to new applicants only applying and getting accepted into a course from 01 February 2025 onwards
- Available to those that are at least 21 years old on 3 March 2025.
- This scholarship or bursary offer is available to Australian citizens, permanent residents, New Zealand Special Category visa (SCV) holder or permanent humanitarian visa holder that meet the residency requirements, commencing their studies in Session 1, 2025, in any of the Diploma or Foundation programs offered at SIBT.
- This scholarship is valued up to \$2,000 for any of the Diploma or Foundation Programs offered at SIBT, which is a reduction of \$250 per subject enrolled for the first 8 subjects of the first program. If a student is required to repeat a subject, the 9th subject will be charged at full price.
- The scholarship has been applied to a standard of four subjects with the initial Letter of Offer, the amount will be adjusted to reflect the final course load when enrolment is completed for session one. If enrolment is less than four subjects, the adjustment will add credit to the student's account, ultimately reducing fees owing for the following session.
- This scholarship is offered by SIBT and can be withdrawn at the discretion of the
- The scholarship will be applied as a credit to the enrolled subject fees each session and cannot be withdrawn or exchanged for cash.
- Students must maintain an average mark of 70% each session to continue to receive the remainder of the scholarship allowance, in the following session. Failure to do so forfeits the remainder of the scholarship allowance. Students who opt in for the GPA Neutral Scheme will still be required to meet the 70% requirement. Their final subject marks will be used to calculate their pass rate.
